GOLF COMPETITIONS NOTES

GENERAL:

1. The **Committee** for the purposes of each competition is comprised of the Golf Convenor and one representative of the Host Club. All Committee decisions are final.
2. The **R & A Rules of Golf** apply to all competitions, in conjunction with **Local Rules** of each of the Host Clubs.
3. Please check in at the Host Club **½ -hour before your scheduled tee off time** as specified on the Draw Sheet supplied in your registration pack.
4. Ensure you complete your **Score Card**, including Home Club Name, Membership ID number, accurate Handicap Index and Course Handicap, and SI Masters Games Competitor Number next to your name. Make sure your card is signed before handing in. Incorrect or incomplete scorecards may result in disqualification.
5. **Competitions are Medal play.** Not completing a hole will result in Disqualification.
6. **Handicaps:**
 - Men: Course Handicap calculated from current index;
 - Women: Course Handicap calculated from current index:
7. Competitors without NZ Golf handicaps will only be eligible to play in the Twilight Competition.
8. **Medals** will be awarded for Nett results in all events. Medals for Gross results will be considered for the Championship events only but on the basis of grouping age grades dependent upon entries. Medals will be awarded as soon as the results are tabulated. Please enjoy the hospitality of the Host Club while these are tabulated. All will have food and drink service available.

Wednesday, 14th October, Geraldine (Denfield) Golf Club – from 12:00 noon

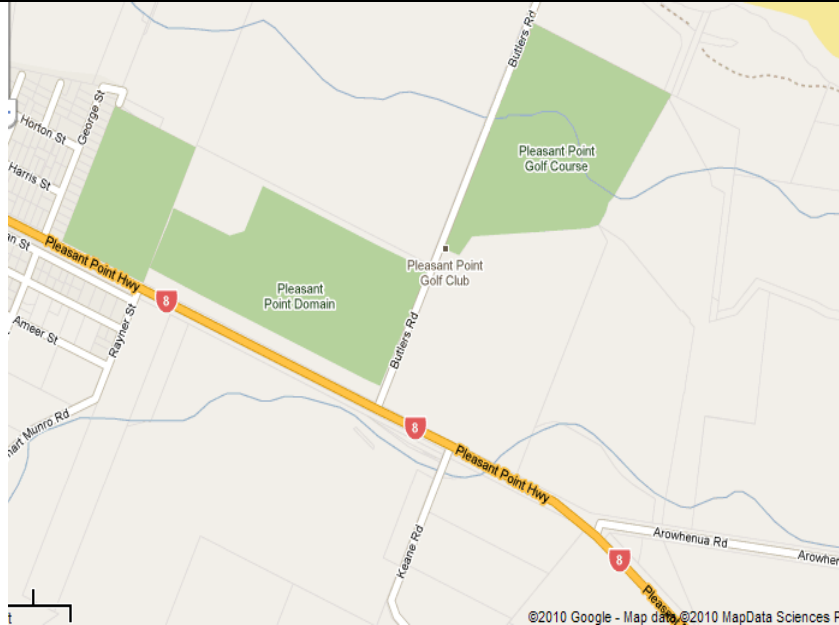
1. The **Men, Women, and Mixed pairs** comprises in 2 age groupings for Nett and Stableford under 60 and over 60+, as numbers in some groupings are limited.
2. Where team members fall into two different age groups, the **team competes at the lower of the two groups** (e.g. Player A is 70+, and A's Partner is 55+, the team competes in the 55+ group.)
3. Players use their own handicaps (women getting extra shots according to the differential between the men's and women's stroke rating) and record the best score of the pair on each hole. Medal allocations for Nett and Stableford scores.

CHAMPIONSHIP MEDAL COMPETITION

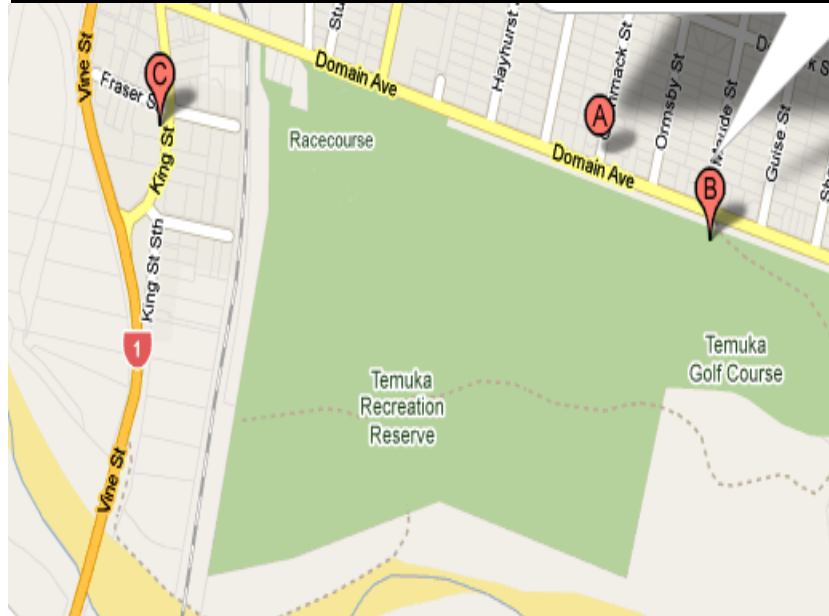
**Thursday, 15th October, Temuka Golf Club – from 12:00 noon, and
Friday, 16th October, Pleasant Point – from 11.00am**

1. Please report to the starter **½ hour before** your tee time on both days.
2. **36 Hole Competitions** over 2 successive days:
 - **Nett** in age groups, though some groups are limited in number.
 - **Gross** merged for Medal allocations as follows:
Women: 2 grades: under 65 and 65+ and over
Men: 3 grades, under 50+ and over, 60+ and over, 70+ and over
3. **Course Handicaps:** Convert your Handicap Index to the Course Handicap – White for Men, Yellow for Women.
4. **PLEASE NOTE:** The 2nd round on Friday starts earlier.
Medals will be awarded at the Pleasant Point GC after the 36-hole results have been tabulated.
